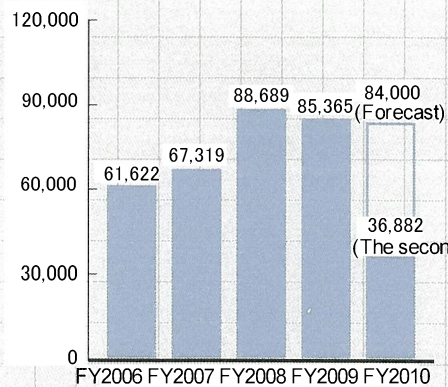

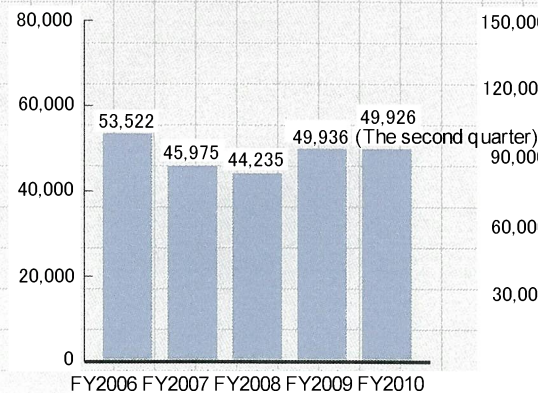
Ordinary profit (million yen)



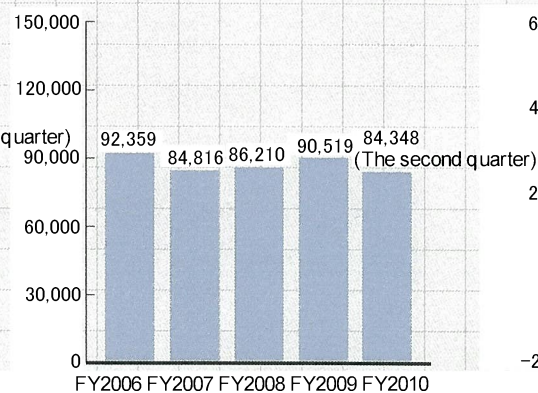
Net income (million yen)



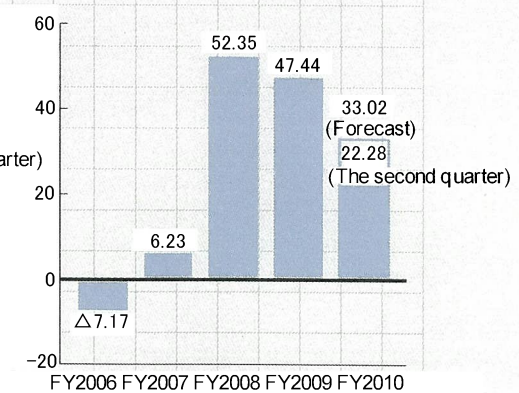
Equity (million yen)

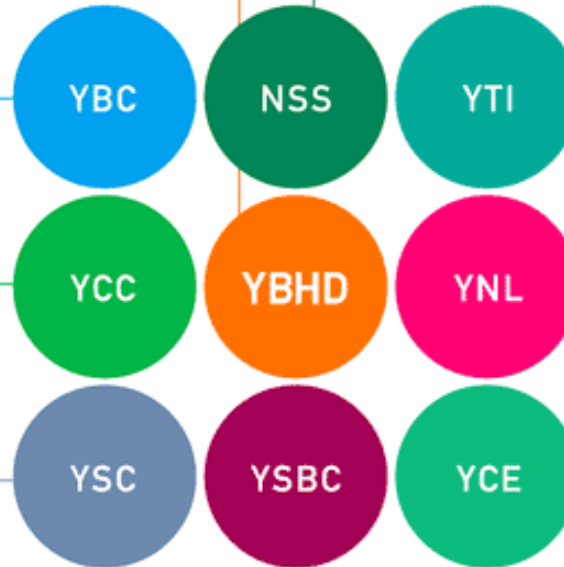
