1. Summary of Business Results, Etc.

(1) Summary of business results for the period

From the three months ended June 30, 2025, changes have been made to the reportable segments, including reclassifying the "engineered structure system business," which had been included in the "engineering business," as an independent segment. The figures of the corresponding period of the previous fiscal year used below for year-on-year comparisons have been reclassified based on the reportable segment classification after the change.

(i) Orders received

In the bridge business, while orders placed were sluggish, the Company was able to win orders from Kinki Regional Development Bureau for the Okutoro Road (Phase 3) Bridge No. 3, East Nippon Expressway for the Ushirozawa Bridge, Metropolitan Expressway for the superstructure reinforcement 3-401, and Nagano Prefecture for the reconstruction of prefecture-maintained national road, among others. Additionally, the Company won overseas major orders, resulting in orders received amounting to 23.08 billion yen (down 15.5% year on year), which is the second highest level following the record high of the same period of the previous fiscal year.

In the engineered structure system business, orders received totaled 10.26 billion yen (up 3.6% year on year), at the same level as the same period of the previous fiscal year. Orders for the small and medium-sized factory and warehouse projects did not reach a full level of recovery. However, inquiries for large projects are steadily progressing. Orders area totaled approximately 0.15 million m² (approximately 0.15 million m² in the same period of the previous fiscal year).

In the engineering business, a year-on-year decrease in orders received was unavoidable due to the large projects in the same period of the previous fiscal year in the civil engineering business, resulting in orders received of 3.87 billion yen (down 57.0% year on year).

In the precision equipment business, orders received stood at 1.03 billion yen (up 4.3% year on year) due to the recovery of demand environment in the precision equipment manufacturing business.

As a result of the above, orders received in the three months ended June 30, 2025, totaled 38.26 billion yen (down 19.0% year on year).

(ii) Business results

For the three months ended June 30, 2025, net sales were 33.45 billion yen (down 6.9% year on year), operating profit was 1.11 billion yen (down 19.4% year on year), and ordinary profit was 1.07 billion yen (down 22.0% year on year). Profit attributable to owners of parent decreased from the same period of the previous year, when a gain on sale of investment securities was recorded, amounting to 0.73 billion yen (down 42.9% year on year). Results by business sector are as follows.

(Bridge Business)

In the bridge business, a decrease in net sales was unavoidable due to backlog order conditions, resulting in net sales of 18.59 billion yen (down 19.2% year on year) and operating profit of 0.71 billion yen (down 52.9% year on year).

(Engineered Structure System Business)

In the engineered structure system business, due to the pickup in backlog of orders, net sales were 9.89 billion yen (up 11.9% year on year) and operating profit was 0.72 billion yen (up 328.8% year on year).

(Engineering Business)

In the engineering business, net sales were 3.67 billion yen (up 17.3% year on year). Operating profit was restrained at 0.02 billion yen (down 76.5% year on year) due to sluggish production volume in the civil engineering business.

(Precision Equipment Business)

In the precision equipment business, net sales were 1.14 billion yen (up 40.1% year on year) and operating profit was 0.15 billion yen (up 328.3% year on year) due to increased orders.

(2) Summary of financial position for the period

Total assets as of June 30, 2025 decreased by 5.87 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year to 210.3 billion yen. Current assets decreased by 7.13 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year, mainly due to a decrease in "notes receivable, accounts receivable from completed construction contracts and other." Non-current assets increased by 1.25 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year due to an increase in "investments and other assets" resulting from rising stock prices and other factors.

Liabilities decreased by 5.66 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year to 81.42 billion yen. This was mainly due to decreases in "notes payable, accounts payable for construction contracts and other" and "income taxes payable."

Net assets decreased by 0.21 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year to 128.87 billion yen. This was mainly due to the recording of "profit attributable to owners of parent," an increase in "valuation difference on available-for-sale securities," and payment of dividends. As a result, the equity ratio stood at 61.3%.
